



Accessing Healthcare Survey

Purpose: To better understand the community's experience when accessing healthcare in the region.

85% of Medicaid/ Uninsured members (86% of All Panel Members) felt they have **limited access to healthcare**.

	Medicaid/ Uninsured	All Panel Members
Dental Care	82%	49%
Specialty Care	27%	46%
Mental Health	55%	35%
Primary Care	0%	16%

Top 3 Perceived Reason for Limited Access to Healthcare

- Lack of Providers in particular specialty
- No or limited health insurance coverage
- Healthcare is too expensive

Most Known Services by Respondents:

- Nutritional/ Affordable Food Access
- Pharmaceutical Access
- Mental Health Services

Least Known Services by Respondents:

- Safe/ Affordable Housing
- Free/ Low Cost Healthcare Options
- Rural Resident Outreach



54% of Medicaid/ Uninsured Members would attend a **free nutrition class**



32% of Medicaid/ Uninsured Members said a **weekday night** is the best time to hold a class

Response Rate: 186 panel members responded to the February/ March 2016 online panel survey. Out of the 186 members, 28 (or 15%) members were Medicaid members or uninsured. The panel members are categorized into 4 categories: Healthcare Providers, Community Organizations, Community Residents, and Medicaid/ Uninsured.
