



Medication Adherence Survey Community Perspective

Purpose: To better understand the communities' perspective in regards to taking prescribed medication.

Biggest Factors that Prevent Individuals from Taking Prescription (s)

Medicaid/ Uninsured

Remembering to take prescription (s)
Affordability of co-pay or cost of prescription (s)
Prescription not covered by insurance



Medicaid/ Uninsured and Community Residents

Remembering to take prescription (s)
Affordability of co-pay or cost of prescription (s)
Fearful of a drug's side effects



72% Know that drug companies have programs that minimize or eliminate out-of-pocket costs for prescriptions



21% Know the Pharmacist has the ability to waive the co-pay

Opportunities for Consideration...

- ◆ Feasibility assessment for home delivery options with area pharmacies
- ◆ Increase awareness of cost mitigation (assistance) programs among Medicaid/ Uninsured individuals
- ◆ Implement prescriptions reminder applications

Response Rate: 142 panel members responded to the mid-October 2018 to January 2019 online panel survey. Out of the 142 members, 47 (or 8%) members were Medicaid members or uninsured. This panel survey only surveyed Medicaid/ Uninsured and Community Residents. Over 80% of those that responded, had taken prescription medications in the last 6 months.
